- 4. "Immediately", Jesus' transforming authority is submitted to by those who <u>follow</u> Him. Mark 1:18 Mark 1:20 Mark 1:28
 - **a.** The Church will only be ready to fulfill its <u>mission</u> when you are ready to fulfill <u>your</u> mission.
