Bring this with you to small group this week.

2.	What are some of the roles we assume as a part of our group travel? What do these roles look like specifically at the Rock? • Romans 12:6-8 • Ephesians 4:11-13
3.	The Bible makes it clear that God expects for us to determine our role on the road trip – and we will be held accountable for what we do or do not do. Read: Matthew 25:14-30, Romans 14:10-12
	What are some of the ramifications of not fulfilling the role God has ordained for us? How does it impact the Kingdom of God and the body of Christ?
4.	Being on a road trip with a group of people who are all learning together can be frustrating. What does the Bible tell us about how we should treat one another through this process? Read: Romans 15:1-5, Ephesians 4:2, Philippians 2:3, Colossians 3:13; 4:6, I Thessalonians 5:11, Hebrews 3:13
5.	What do you need to do to get started functioning in your role? Do you need more information, encouragement, or support? How can small groups help?
