# **Extreme Home Takeover**

**Book of Joshua Master Quiz**

### 1. Background

First five books - <u>Torah</u>, main characters - Abraham, Isaac, Jacob and Moses Genesis - <u>beginnings</u>, Exodus - <u>exit from Egypt</u>, Leviticus - <u>holiness</u>, Numbers - <u>wandering</u>, Deuteronomy - <u>second law</u>.

Second twelve books - <u>historical books</u> - main characters Joshua, Judges and Kings Joshua's conquest.

### 2. Key People

Joshua and Moses, born <u>slaves</u> in Egypt, had a <u>face to face</u> encounter with God. They were told to take off <u>shoes</u> on <u>holy</u> ground, lead Israel through miraculously parted <u>water</u>, send <u>spies</u> into the PL, and obeyed the commandments of God. Moses spoke to the <u>Lord</u> through the <u>burning bush</u>, while Joshua spoke to the <u>commander</u> of the armies of the <u>Lord. Exodus 3. Joshua 5</u>

Moses died at 120 and Joshua at 110. Joshua 24:29

Joshua was one of <u>two</u> faithful spies (Caleb) at <u>Kadesh Barnea</u>, led Israel in battle against the <u>Amalekites</u>, faithfully served Moses on the mountain and in the tent of meeting. **Numbers 13, Exodus 17, Joshua 34** 

## 3. Joshua's Qualifications/Calling

Joshua served Moses on the <u>mountain</u>, **Exodus 24:13, 32:17**, in the <u>tent</u> of meeting, **Exodus 33:11**, led military battles, **Exodus 17**. Honored for <u>faithfulness</u> **Numbers 26:65**. Joshua, like Jesus, had the same name <u>Yeshua</u>, <u>Jehovah saves</u>. He conquered the P.L. accomplishing with <u>grace</u> what the <u>law</u> could not. **2 Corinthians 2:14** says *Jesus always leads His people in <u>victory</u>.* 

### 4. Warning

Joshua was told not to FEAR - <u>False Expectations Appearing Real</u> because the job would be very <u>difficult</u>. Therefore he was encouraged to be <u>chazaq</u>, "to show oneself strong." The strength of purpose that enables one to withstand fear or difficulty.

#### 5. Miraculous Start

The crossing of the Jordan was their first <u>woo</u> miracle. Woo miracles require <u>action</u>, they had to place their feet in the water before it <u>parted</u>. Woo miracles <u>glorify</u> God and are always <u>necessary</u> and leave <u>evidence</u>. The Israelites were instructed to take <u>12</u> stones from the midst of the Jordan, one for each of the 12 tribes.

#### 6. Geography

Joshua conquered the land with a "divide and conquer" mindset, through three major military campaigns; the first being the central, the second being the southern and the third being in the north over a 7 year period. Gilgal means rolling, location of the 12 stones of remembrance from the Jordan crossing and the base of Israel's military operations. The first place the ark settled, Joshua 6-10. The first Passover in Canaan, Joshua 5:9-10, the second circumcision. Shiloh, 'Peacemaker', the religious center after Gilgal until it was stolen by the Philistines and taken to Ahdod. 1 Samuel 4-5. Shechem; a city of refuge was situated between Mt. Ebal and Mt. Gerizim. Hebron, the city taken by Caleb, land of giants.

#### 7. Victories

Rahab was a <u>harlot</u> who lived on the <u>wall</u> in the city of <u>Jericho</u>. She expressed her faith in God by <u>hiding</u> and <u>informing</u> the <u>spies</u> of Israel and placing a <u>scarlet</u> cord in her window, and became and ancestor to King <u>David</u> and <u>Jesus</u> by marriage. Victory over the enemy was secured by <u>faith</u> in God's tactics, not <u>size</u> and strength of the army. They defeated Jericho by marching around the city once for <u>six</u> days and then <u>7</u> times around the city on the seventh day. They then blew the <u>trumpets</u> and the people <u>shouted</u> and the <u>walls</u> fell down. The <u>Gibeonites</u> tricked Israel with <u>molded</u> bread and worn out <u>clothes</u>. Enemy traps from trickery can be avoided by seeking the <u>counsel</u> of God. Israel defeated the 5 conquering kings with <u>hail stones</u>, the <u>sun</u> and moon stood <u>still</u> for 24 hours. **Joshua 10** 

#### 8. Sin in the camp

They were defeated by Ai because there was sin in the camp. <u>Achan</u> hid stolen item in his tent. Secret sin produces <u>collateral</u> damage, and will always <u>find</u> you out. It must be <u>confronted</u> by the people, <u>confessed</u> by the guilty and <u>removed</u> to secure God's <u>blessing</u>.

The Levites were descendants of <u>Levi</u> and were not given an inheritance of land because God was their inheritance. They had <u>48</u> Levitical cities, 13 cities for the priests and <u>6</u> cities of <u>refuge</u> for the <u>manslayer</u> to run from the <u>avenger</u> of blood. A manslayer was someone who killed another by accident and was not deserving of the <u>death</u> sentence.

<u>Two and half tribes</u> to settle on the east side were <u>Reuben</u>, <u>Gad and the half tribe</u> <u>of Manasseh</u>. They had to assist in conquering the land on the west side before they were allowed to settle on the east side. This took <u>7 years</u>. They built an impressive <u>altar</u> to remind them to only serve the God that deliver them from <u>Egypt</u>. The nation of Israel went to <u>war</u> with them but in the end, peace prevailed. This altar was called <u>Witness</u>.

A Witness is someone or something that add value to the <u>fact finding</u> process. Stones when they crossed the Jordan, **Joshua 4:6-7**. The <u>impressive</u> altar of the two and half tribes, **Joshua 22:34**, the <u>people</u> themselves, **Joshua 24:22**. Stones with <u>law</u> written on them, **Joshua 24:27**.
