The Greek word "mathetes" is translated as our English word disciple, which is used in and outside of the Bible as a general term for a <u>Learner or Follower</u> of another's teaching. However, Jesus Himself used the word 'mathetes' less than a dozen times. One was a command and seven times He used the words, "My disciple(s)" in a Conditional Sense!

- 4. Stewards his possessions rather than clinging to them (Luke 14:33)
- 5. Abides in God's Word (John 8:31)
- 6. Loves other followers of Jesus (John 13:35)
- 7. Bears much fruit (John 15:8)
