The Invisible Man QUIZ

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The Trinity is One God Three <u>Persons</u>. The Father establishes the <u>plan</u> of salvation. Jesus <u>signed</u> the contract in His <u>blood</u> and the Holy Spirit was sent to <u>implement</u> the plan of salvation. The Invisible Man or Holy Spirit is like a <u>fire</u> - Acts 2, <u>dove</u> - Matthew 3, wind - John 3

The Invisible Man, Like God is: omnipresent - Psalm 139:7-10, omniscient - 2 Corinthians 2:10-12, omnipotent - Genesis 1:2, Job 33:4 and eternal, Hebrews 9:14. He is called The Spirit of God-1 John 4:2, 1 Corinthians 3:16, 1 Corinthians 2:10. Spirit of Christ - 1 Peter 1:11. Hagios - Matthew 28:19-20, 2 Corinthians 13:14. The Invisible Man is a He'-1 John 16:7-14. Lives in you - John 14:17. Has a mind - Romans 8:27. A will - 1 Corinthians 12:11. Can be grieved - Ephesians 4:30-32. Loves you - Romans 15:30.

The Invisible Man Speaks - John 16:13, Acts 8:29. He sounds like <u>small</u>, <u>still voice</u>, a <u>groan</u>, speaks biblical <u>truth</u>, and cries out "<u>daddy</u>." He <u>reminds</u> us of what Jesus <u>said</u>, who Jesus <u>is</u>, and <u>leads</u> us into truth. He wants us to <u>speak</u> like Him. Separates you from <u>yourself</u>, the <u>world</u>, <u>death</u> and unto <u>Himself</u> - 2 Corinthians 3:17-18, Acts 13:2-3, Luke 4:18-19, Romans 8:11. He <u>convicts</u> the world of sin and leads us into <u>truth</u>.

The Invisible Man Provides Access to God Himself – Ephesians 2:15-18. God's <u>power</u> – Acts 1:8. The <u>freedom</u> to say Jesus is Lord- 1 John 4:2. He writes scriptures - 2 Peter 1:20-21. Interprets scripture, calls us into ministry. Come upon you, <u>seal</u> you, <u>anoint</u> you, fill you, <u>baptize</u> you - 1 Corinthians 1:22, Matthew 3:11.

The Invisible Man Gives Gifts – Gifts are the <u>supernatural</u> manifestation of the Spirit to empower you to serve the kingdom of God - 1 Corinthians 12:7. Do not be <u>ignorant</u> to your gifts - 1 Corinthians 12:1. No one person has <u>all</u> the gifts. We need <u>each other</u> - 1 Corinthians 12:14-21, 28-30. We need to create an <u>environment</u> for the gifts to operate - Ezra 7:10, Romans 12:1-2, 1 Corinthians 3:5-8. Seek opportunities to fulfill our role in the body of Christ - 1 Corinthians 12:13, 18, Romans 12:3-6, 2 Timothy 1:6-7. The activities of the Holy Spirit are <u>mysterious</u>. **Natural** talents are limited to depending on the <u>flesh</u> and glorifying man. **Spiritual gifts** depend solely on the <u>Spirit</u> and only glorify Jesus.

The Invisible Man Baptizes Us: Baptism, Baptizo: immersion, <u>plunge</u>. Filled with the Holy Spirit, <u>baptized</u> by the Holy Spirit, <u>a second</u> blessing, <u>third</u>, and <u>fourth</u>. All are baptized with the Holy Spirit at the point of <u>salvation</u> - 1 Corinthians 12:13, John 3:3-6, Matthew 3:11. Holy Spirit Baptism <u>empowers</u> us to be a witness - Acts 1:8. Holy Spirit baptism should be an <u>ongoing</u> process – Ephesians 5:18 "be ye filled..." Holy Spirit Baptism is not a result of you getting more of the Holy Spirit but the Holy Spirit getting more of <u>you</u>.

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
