Jesus' critics looked for ways to accuse Him. Mark 3:2 Jesus' critics tried to trap Him in His words. Matthew 22:15-34 Jesus' critics paid people to lie. Matthew 26:14-16; Matthew 27:1-5 Jesus' response - Live in truth.

The only reason someone attempts to prevent a truth to prevail is because they are threatened by that truth.

3. Attempts to stone Jesus for blasphemy prove He ______ to be

God. Matthew 26:65; Daniel 7

Jesus claimed equality with God. John 5:16-18 Jesus claimed to be the 'I AM'. Exodus 3; John 8:58 Jesus claimed to be the Anointed One. Luke 4:16-30 Jesus forgave sin. Luke 5:21; Mark 2:6 Jesus accepts worship. Matthew 8:1; John 9:38; Matthew 14:33 Jesus' response - Live in relationship with God.
