1. Worship places the battle in the Lord's hands. 2 Chronicles 20:12-17

Worship admits our weakness and God's strength. Worship anticipates God's help.

2. Worship reminds Satan of his weakness before God. Ephesians 6:12, 13; 2 Corinthians 10:4

3. Worship reminds our hearts of our real <u>hope</u>. 2 Chronicles 20:12-17

Worship acknowledges your reliance on God. Worship aligns us with God.
