Exposed takes a close look at the "cult of personality" that occupies so much of pop-culture's time and focus. We are quick to judge celebrities and be entertained by their downfall, while in reality our lives are often just as broken.

CONDEMN: The act of pronouncing someone guilty after weighing the evidence. ${ }^{1}$

The evidence is their life, therefore we have to wait for all the evidence to come in.
