The four kids of dysfunction:

Hero – super kid, the little parent Scapegoat – troublemaker Loner – the quiet one who flies under the radar Mascot – family or class clown

- A What the mascot looks like on the outside:
  - Funny, hysterical, anything for a laugh, cute, immature
- **B** What the mascot feels on the inside:
  - Hides pain with humor, scared, feels inadequate
- **C** What the mascot means to the family:
  - They bring comic relief to the family
  - They help the family avoid issues
- **D** As an adult without help:
  - Continues to build up pain
  - Lets others tell them what to do too much
  - Too much of a follower
  - Never grows up
- E What the mascot can become:
  - Can feel a range of emotion
  - Can use laughter in good ways
  - Learns to take the lead more
  - Grows up into more responsibility
