

The Hebrew word for altar, "mizbeach," means "a place where sacrifices were offered." It comes from the verbal root zabach, "to slaughter for sacrifices."

The altar is:

- 1. A place to acknowledge His holy <u>presence</u> Genesis 12:7, 13:4, 18
- 2. A place to give God sole credit as the <u>source</u> of all your needs. *Genesis 22:9*
- 3. A place to give up <u>falsehood</u> and sin. *Matthew 5:23-24*
- 4. A place to give an <u>acceptable offering</u> or sacrifice. *Genesis 22:9, Romans 12:1-2*
