How to Unleash the Revolutionary Within You!

Revolutionary Leaders:

1. Never of when they were rescued!

Then Jesus answered and said, "A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, who stripped him of his clothing, wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead. Now by chance a certain priest came down that road. And when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. Likewise a Levite, when he arrived at the place, came and looked, and passed by on the other side. -Luke 10:30-32 (NKJV)

A revolutionary is a person who understands the pain of the people they have been called to liberate!

Rescue the perishing; don't hesitate to step in and help. If you say, "Hey, that's none of my business," will that get you off the hook? Someone is watching you closely, you know - Someone not impressed with weak excuses. -Proverbs 24:11-12 (MSG)

"God whispers to us in our success, but shouts in our pain." -C. S. Lewis

My dear friends, if you know people who have wandered off from God's truth, don't write them off. Go after them. Get them back and you will have rescued precious lives from destruction and prevented an epidemic of wandering away from God. -James 5:19-20

2. Never forget to allow themselves to be and moved by the condition of others!

> But a certain Samaritan, as he journeved, came where he was. And when he saw him, he had compassion. -Luke 10:33 (NKJV)

But when [Jesus] saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. -Matthew 9:36 (NKJV)

Speak up for the people who have no voice, for the rights of all the down-and- outers. Speak out for justice! Stand up for the poor and destitute! -Proverbs 31:8-9 (MSG)

In this way, Aaron will carry the names of the tribes of Israel on the sacred chestpiece over his heart when he goes into the Holy Place. This will be a continual reminder that he represents the people when he comes before the Lord. -Exodus 28:29 (NLT)

3. Never forget to risk their and to love people back to life!

> So he went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine; and he set him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him. On the next day, when he departed, he took out two denarii, gave them to the innkeeper, and said to him, 'Take care of him; and whatever more you spend, when I come again, I will repay you. -Luke 10:34-35 (NKJV)

Then the eleven disciples left for Galilee, going to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. The moment they saw Him they worshiped Him. Some, though, held back, not sure about worship, about risking themselves totally. -Matthew 28:16-17 (MSG)

And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart. -Galatians 6:9 (NKJV)
