*Metaphor: A figure of speech in which a word or phrase is **symbolic** of something else.*

Our giving is symbolic of where our hearts are. **Matthew 6:21**

Thankfulness: An expression of being aware, pleased, or satisfied with a received benefit

Generous: Something given in abundance, bountifully, or unselfishly

Unhealthy: When something is not working according to its design

Healthy: When something is working according to its design
