Generosity - Assigning God's blessing to its proper place

Greed - Withholding God's blessing from its proper place

ASK God for His Heart

Assess the condition of your heart. *Our heart changes moment to moment.*

-Does your heart ache to be generous or greedy?

Search Scripture for the conviction of God's heart. *God's conviction is consistent.*

-Joshua 6:15-19

Knit your heart with God. *A deliberate and constant surrender.*

1. Father, give me a heart that DESIRES to grow in generosity. **Joshua 7:10-11**

2. Jesus, create in me a heart that CONNECTS "blessings" to generosity and "curses" to greed. **Joshua 7:20**

3. Holy Spirit, develop a heart in me that PURSUES the blessings of generosity through generosity.

Discussion Question: Do you give or tithe faithfully? If yes, describe the blessing you receive. If no, why not?

Asking Jesus into your life is as easy as A-B-C

Gospel A-B-C's // Father, I Admit that I am a sinner and that my sin has brought death and destruction into my life, my relationships with people, and my relationship with God. **Romans 3:23, 6:23**

I Believe that Jesus died for my sins and that His death paid the penalty for my sins. **Romans 5:8**

I Confess or agree that Jesus is Lord, that He died and rose from the dead, and is able to forgive me of my sins. **Romans 10:9-10**

Jesus, I trust that You love me and can hear my prayer. By faith, I ask You to please forgive me and fill me with the Holy Spirit. I surrender my life to You. I pray this in Jesus' name. Amen.
