The Prophet: A mouthpiece or "Nabi" of "a Word" that "becomes a thing" that expands the "kingdom of God."
The Old Testament prophet was God's only conduit to speak to the nations.
The New Testament prophecy is based on the fact that God speaks to and through anyone.
1. "A Word" – A spontaneous <u>revelation</u> from God such as a declaration, a vision, an image, an idea, an insight. <i>Isaiah 6:6-9</i>
