MAIN POINTS:

1. In Old Testament times, children were usually named by their mothers. These “E” and “Yah” ensured honor to and involvement of God in their children’s lives.
2. Changing names reveals a divine identity and purpose. (Gen 17:1-5; 32:28)
3. A biblical name records aspects of a person at birth.
4. Biblical names expressed a divine assignment at birth. (Matthew 1:23)
5. Biblical names communicate God’s message.
