Team Member Serve Standards

These are the requirements for team members at Rock Church. The goal is to create unity, clarity, and consistency throughout the team so that we can work together to help execute the mission and vision of our church. The Team Member Playbook:

- · Submit the Join the Team serve form
- · Attend LIFE Class & Complete Background Check
- Team Member Documents & Interview
- Complete all phases of team member onboarding process & training
- Serve a minimum of 2 Sundays per month

- Attend team member check-in meeting after 90 days of serving
- Serve 1 service and attend 1 service on Sundays that you are serving
- Attend Enrichments/Team Member Nights/Regular 1:1's with Team Leader
- Complete 2 new steps on the Discipleship Pathway each year

Team Leader Standards

These are the requirements for becoming a Team Leader/Captain/Coach at Rock Church.

- · Complete all Team Member Serve Standards
- · Attend Encounter before leading
- Complete Leadership Training at appropriate level
- · Complete Leadership Interview
- · Complete Group leader training

Team Leadership Structure

Our leadership structure is designed to bring clarity to the roles and responsibilities for our staff and team members. By clearly defining a leadership structure that spans the entire organization and every ministry team, we can ensure consistency in how ministry is being executed across the organization.

- Senior Pastor (staff) Determines mission and vision and establishes the overall direction of the church.
- Executive Team (staff) Ensures the effective execution of the mission and vision across all areas of the church.
- Staff (staff) Develop and deploy strategies to ensure the overall effective execution of the mission and vision in specific areas of ministry.
- Coach (volunteer) Ensure team captains are equipped, resourced, and engaged in the strategies for effective execution of the mission and vision in specific areas of ministry.

- Team Captain (volunteer) Develop and ensure team leaders are facilitating and implementing the strategies for effective execution of the mission and vision in specific areas of ministry.
- Team Leader (volunteer) Develop and ensure team members are performing the specific tasks that are designed to ensure the effective execution of the mission and vision in specific areas of ministry.
- Team Member (volunteer) Execute the specific tasks that are designed to ensure the effective execution of the mission and vision in specific areas of ministry.
